

OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 Section 14(1), (5) & (7)

Temporary relocation of 7.5t weight limit

Watchfield, Majors Road to High Street

Date of Order: 24 November 2014 Coming into force: 26 November 2014

This order is being introduced because of dwelling construction works which are anticipated to take 18 months to complete. The effect of the order is to temporarily remove the 7.5 tonne weight prohibition in Majors Road (130 metres east of its junction with High Street) and relocate it in High Street immediately south of its junction with Majors Road to prohibit HGVs using the High Street as a though route. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed to indicate when the measures are in force.

Exemptions are included for emergency services. The alternative route for HGVs is via Faringdon Road and Majors Road and vice versa.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Majors Road, Watchfield) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order 1989 will be temporarily amended.

This order will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
